- Obtained summary judgment for an electrical contractor in a

 alleged the general contractor and several electric companies
 working on-site were negligent in causing serious injuries
 sustained by the plaintiff. Through a thorough investigation,
 MWH was able to demonstrate that a scrap piece of conduit,
 which the plaintiff allegedly slipped on, had been shaped into
 a makeshift spinning tool by a tradesperson responsible for
 hanging ceiling wire and tiles.
